### Psalm 93

#### Getting Started

What has helped you grasp something of the awesomeness and majesty of God?

#### Digging In

1. **Read Psalm 93.** What do we learn about God's character from this psalm. List as many attributes as you can.
2. Write a paraphrase of v. 1.
3. In your own words, what does it mean that "the LORD is robed in majesty"?
4. Think of the problems in society. What difference does it make that "the LORD reigns"?
5. Think of the challenges you are personally facing. What difference does it make that the LORD "is armed with strength," that "the LORD on high is mighty"?
6. What are the implications for our lives of the psalmist's statement in v. 5 that "holiness adorns" the LORD's house?
7. **Read Psalm 19:1-6.** According to these verses, what is one way that God reveals himself to us?
8. **Read Psalm 19:7-11.** What is a second way that we learn something about God, specifically, his will and his character?
9. **Read John 1:1-3 and 1:14-18.** In addition to revealing truth about himself through *his world* and *his word*, how else has God made himself known to us? (cf. also Hebrews 1:1-3)



#### Getting Personal

- In what ways do our behavior and attitudes sometimes betray a deficient understanding of God?
- How is Paul's deep desire to know Christ seen in Philippians 3:3-11?
- How can we follow Paul's example?
- What would it look like for you personally to grow in your knowledge of God? What differences would it make in your life – your attitudes, your conversation, your response to problems?
