Read 2 Peter 3:14-18

- 1. Let us strive for peace. (v. 14)**
 - a. How is a person found spotless and blameless?
 - i. Read Romans 5:1-11
 - ii. Read Jude 1:24-25
 - b. What is the reason for the apostle Peter instructing the churches to be at peace with God?
- 2. There is hope in God's patience. (vv. 15-16)**
 - a. Why is the apostle Peter saying God's patience is salvation?
 - i. Could the salvation that the apostle Peter is talking about mean the judgement of Jesus has not yet come upon them?
 - ii. Read 2 Peter 3:9-11.
 - b. How does the apostle Peter characterize the false teachers?

 - a. What was the apostle Peter's warning to the churches?
 - b. What are the churches to guard against?

 - d. What is the apostle Peter's main point in his concluding remarks in verses 17-18?
