***Getting Started***

***Review***

1. **Read Eph 1:3-6.** Why did God **choose** us?
2. For what purpose did God **predestine** us?

***Digging In***

1. In vss. 3-14 Paul lists a number of spiritual blessings that we've been given in Christ. **Read Eph 1:7-8.** What great blessing is mentioned in v. 7?
2. To **redeem** means to deliver or rescue. **From what** has God rescued us? (See Gal 3:13; Col 1:13-14)
3. **How** did God redeem us? (See 1 Pet 1:18-19)
4. For what **purpose** did God redeem us? (See Titus 2:11-14)
5. How else are the riches of God's grace seen in v. 8?
6. **Read Eph 1:9-10.** In Scripture, a **mystery** is not something spooky and unknowable. Rather it is a truth that was once concealed that has now been revealed. In vss. 9-10, what mystery does Paul say God has made known to us?
7. How does this mystery underscore the supremacy of Christ? (See Colossians 1:15-20)
8. How are God's sovereignty and authority seen in these verses?
