2. **Read John 3:16.** According to this verse, for whom did God show his love? Explain.
3. How did God demonstrate his love for the world? (Romans 5:8)
4. Why was this necessary? (Rom 3:23; 6:23)
5. What does it mean that *God gave his one and only Son*?
6. What additional insights do we get from:
  - 2 Corinthians 5:21
  - 1 Peter 2:24
7. **Read John 14:6.** Are there other ways to God? Explain.
8. How can we receive God's gift of eternal life? (Jn 3:16)
9. In your own words, what does it mean to *believe in him*?
10. What if we choose **not** to believe in Jesus? (v. 18)
11. **Read Eph 2:8-10.** Can good works make up for our sin? Explain.
12. What can we expect to see in the life of a person who truly believes in Jesus? (1 John 2:3-6)
