1. Read Luke 10:25-37.
2. Mike stated, "We're more than our parts or functions. We're not 'human doings, we're human beings.'" What did he mean by this? Why is this distinction important in the abortion debate?
3. Why does the Christian view of human life provide the "Only unshakable foundation for human equality"?
4. What are the only 4 differences between the adult you are today and the embryo that you once were? What's wrong with appealing to these to justify abortion?
5. How would you respond to someone who claimed that the Bible is silent on the subject of abortion?
6. Why do you think so many Christians and churches are reluctant to speak up for the preborn?
7. How does the church's silence sentence those who've been hurt by abortion to suffer alone?
8. In what way is responding to abortion a "gospel issue"?
9. Do you think it was a stretch for Mike to apply Jesus' Parable of The Good Samaritan to the battle for life in our land? Why or why not?
