1. How many times have you read the book of Proverbs?
2. What would you say the book of Proverbs is all about?
3. There are three major words used at least seven times together in Proverbs. What are they?
4. One of the three words is *knowledge*. How do you define *knowledge*?
5. Give some facts we know from the Bible.
6. What is *wisdom*?
7. What is the relationship between *knowledge* and *wisdom*?
8. Is it possible to have knowledge but at the same time not to have wisdom? Explain.
9. Give an illustration of wisdom being based upon a Biblical principle rather than a direct statement or command.
10. If knowledge answers the question of “what,” and wisdom answers the question of “how,” what question does understanding answer?
11. Proverbs 4:5-7 exhorts us to get understanding. How can we “get understanding”? Clue: Look at the rest of chapter 4.
12. What does Proverbs 9:10 teach us about obtaining understanding?
