***Getting Started***

What's the first thing that comes to mind when you hear the word *disciple*?

***Digging In***

1. In Matthew 28:18-20, what did Jesus instruct his disciples to do?
2. Jesus said to "make disciples". How would you describe a person who is a good example of a "disciple"?
3. Is a disciple of Jesus expected to obey everything Jesus taught, or is 80% good enough? Explain.
4. Who do you think Jesus intended to fulfill his command to "make disciples"? Is it for all followers of Jesus, or just for certain ones who are specially called and gifted?
5. For whom did Jesus make his promise in verse 20?
6. What is the difference between a "typical Christian" and a "biblical Christian" as described in the message on Sunday?
7. Luke 14:25-27 says that in order to follow Jesus we need to love him more than anyone – even ourselves. What are some of the relationships or things that – at times – we might love more than God?
