**Read Jude 1-10.** List some of the accusations Jude levels against the false teachers that had infiltrated the church? (vv. 4, 8-10)

#### ***Digging In***

1. **Read Jude 11-16.** Write down your first impressions.
2. Jude compares the false teachers to 3 well-known Old Testament villains. What sins were typified by:
  - a. the way of *Cain*? (Gen 4:5-8)
  - b. *Balaam's error*? (Num 22-24; 2 Pet 2:15)
  - c. *Korah's rebellion*? (Num 16:1-14)
3. How were these false teachers like *hidden reefs* at the church's community meals?
4. How did they fail as shepherds?
5. What do you think Jude means by calling the false teachers *clouds without rain* and *autumn trees, without fruit*?
6. How were the false teachers like *wild waves of the sea* and *wandering stars*?
7. What will be their certain destiny? (vv. 11,13-14)
8. What further charges does Jude bring against them in v. 16?

- How can this passage help us to recognize false teachers today?
- Are there any ways in which you can identify with these false teachers, e.g. jealousy, greed, selfishness, immorality, grumbling, faultfinding, or boasting?
- What are you doing to build a solid biblical worldview so that you are less vulnerable to the lies and enticements of false teachers?
