1. **Read Ac 10:1-8.** In your own words, how would you describe Cornelius and his family?
2. Paraphrase Cornelius' encounter with an angel in a vision.
3. What instructions did the angel give Cornelius? How did Cornelius respond?
4. **Read vss. 9-16.** What was Peter doing as the men sent by Cornelius were nearing Joppa?
5. Describe Peter's vision. Why was Peter reluctant to obey?
6. What was the greater meaning of what Peter was told in v. 15?
7. **Read vss. 17-23.** How did the Spirit prepare Peter to receive the messengers from Cornelius, and to go with them?
8. What evidence is there that Peter's heart is beginning to change?
9. **Read vss. 24-33.** How had Cornelius prepared for Peter's visit?
10. How did Peter explain why he'd come?
11. What key points does Cornelius make in summarizing his vision?
