4. **Read v. 20 & 22.** How did God reconcile us to himself?

5. What did it cost God to reconcile us to himself. (cf. John 3:16; Romans 5:6-8)

6. **Why** did God reconcile us to himself. What purposes does Paul list in v. 22?

7. Write a paraphrase of v. 22. (Put the verse in your own words.)

8. **Read v. 23.** What is the evidence that a person has truly been reconciled to God?

9. How is Christ's role as reconciler seen in the angel's announcement to Joseph? (Matt 1:18-21)

10. How did an angel make the same point when he appeared to the shepherds to tell them of Jesus' birth? (Luke 2:8-12)
